

The Ice Cream Parlor at the Deanna Rose Children's Farmstead

To be located on Main Street – the final expansion area of the Farmstead – is an old-fashioned Ice Cream Parlor and Confectionary!

It will be at the east end of the the Kansas Farm Trail, next to the bank (made possible by a generous gift from legendary Overland Park banker Ben Craig and opening in April, 2010) and the General Store and across from the new Farmstead Entry Building. Main Street will provide visitors with another glimpse of life on the Kansas Prairie 100 years ago. Not only that, but the ice cream parlor will be fully operational selling hand-dipped ice cream, candies and fudge, and other treats that have delighted us for generations – like root beer floats, candied apples and chocolate-dipped bananas – yum-m-m-m!



Projected date of opening is April 2011.

The Hoffman Family Foundation provided the lead gift, and they have chosen to name the new attraction after their grandchildren so it will be known as “Alex and Emily’s Ice Cream Parlor.” Friends of the Farmstead designated the proceeds from Night of the Living Farm and Pumpkin Hollow for the last two years and next year for the Ice Cream Parlor and sold actual and symbolic ice cream cones throughout the 2009 season. These grassroots fundraising efforts have totaled nearly \$200,000 to date. In addition, Danisco USA Inc. is the proud sponsor of the authentic back bar which was once located in Spring Hill.
